VENDOR RULES October 24, 2009

Set-Up Time:

Access to the site for set-up is available between 10:00am & 7:00pm, Friday, October 23, 2009, or between 8:00am & 10:00am Saturday, October 24, 2009.

Booths should be set up and ready by 10:00am on Saturday, October 24, 2009.

Price:

\$50.00 with water & electricity or \$35.00 without. **Space among cooking teams-Without Electricity/Water: \$175.00**

All application fees must be postmarked no later than Wednesday, October 21, 2009. Placement will be subject to the approval of the NCBC committee and on "first come first served basis".

Please be advised:

- No booth may give away nor sell food or drinks except as approved by the NCBC committee. The NCBC Committee has the right to refuse any vendor.
- Vendors failing to comply with all rules may be required to leave the grounds and forfeit all monies.
- Booths cannot be shared or subleased.
- The receipt of your application and fee is a commitment to show. Once accepted, No fees will be refunded after October 18, 2009.
- Exhibitors shall not block path with displays or persons promoting your booth. Exhibitors must keep within your assigned space.
- Hours for the show are 10:00am – 5:00pm.
- Please do not disassemble your booth until after the completion of the awards ceremony at 4:00pm.
- It is herein agreed by both parties that NCBC will retain full control and sale of any items bearing the name of National Championship Barbecue Cookoff.
- Exhibitor must supply a detailed listing of all items to be sold. NCBC has the right to refuse any item deemed inappropriate for this event and remove any offensive or inappropriate merchandise or displays.
- Exhibitors are responsible for their own set up, such as tables, chairs or whatever may be needed for their display.
- Exhibitor is responsible for their own equipment in case of loss or damage.
- Any exhibitor should collect sales tax if they are not exempt and are responsible for reporting their own tax to the Texas State Comptroller.
- Please make sure to have your booth open and staffed during all the hours of the event.
- All exhibitors are responsible for any permits including health permits for the sale of food.
- Exhibitor agrees to comply with all local, city and state laws, ordinances and regulations covering fire, safety, health, and all other matters. All exhibit equipment and materials will be reasonably located within the booth space and protected by safe guards and devices when necessary. The Exhibitor will take necessary fire precautions, including having an extinguisher on hand if any flammable items or open flames will be present in the exhibitors booth.
